*“Enhancing Moral Responsibility. New Perspectives on Free Will and Moral Artificial Intelligence”*

**ABSTRACT:** Through an analysis of the contemporary debate on free will and its limitations, this thesis proposes a new "libertarian" perspective aimed at strengthening agent control over moral decision-making, thereby enhancing individual moral responsibility. This form of "procedural moral enhancement" may be supported by a type of Moral AI, referred to as the "Procedural Artificial Moral Assistant," whose function would be to integrate with and assist moral agents by enriching their moral competence and the overall framework of their decision-making processes, while upholding values such as autonomy, ethical pluralism, and other principles characteristic of domain-specific experts.
